INSTRUCTIONS:

- · Please allow 30 days for processing. Keep a copy of this document for your records.
- You must include a copy of the original dates sales receipt with this application
- Include your account number and sign the form
- Incomplete applications will not be processed for rebates
- Submit completed application and sales receipt to your local electric cooperative within 90 days of purchase
- · Additional terms and conditions apply. See the back of this form for details.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 1. Must be a member in good standing with the cooperative
- 2. Audits are available for new or existing homes
- 3. On new homes, it is recommended that the audit take place after the home is sealed and before sheet rock and insulation have been installed.
- 4. A separate audit form must be completed for each installation site
- 5. Must comply with the Home Audit Measure Procedures outlined below
- 6. Multiple occupancy (apartments, duplexes, dormitories) buildings are eligible for a weatherization rebate on a single structure basis, (not a single unit basis). One cost-shared audit on a single unit can be paid to the co-op to determine base-line energy use. The building owner is eligible for the weatherization rebate (up to \$750).

REBATE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Member/auditor must fill in all information requested on the AECI Residential Energy Audit 5-page form located at the Take Control & Save area of AECI's Member's web site.
- 2. Member/auditor must submit the form to local cooperative
- 3. Cooperative must verify account number, name and address of member
- 4. Rebate program is limited to cooperative services that purchase 6,000 or more kilowatt-hours from the cooperative on an annual basis. Eligible services include lake homes, workshops, and barns, etc.

DISCLAIMER

The cooperative is not responsible if your contractor, retailer, builder or other party provides you with inaccurate information about the amount or conditions of the actual rebate. The cooperative will not rebate equipment that has been mislabeled, misrepresented or previously owned. The cooperative reserves the right to inspect the equipment and its installation at the address indicated on the front of this application. The cooperative is not responsible for any lost, late, stolen, ineligible, misdirected or postage due mail. All completed applications will become the property of the cooperative. Rebate qualifications and amounts are subject to change at the cooperative's discretion and the program may end at any time without notice.
